Association of Accounting Technicians of Sri Lanka

The Association of Accounting Technicians of Sri Lanka - AAT Sri Lanka was established in December 1987 on the initiative of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka, and is the only professional institute conducting Accountancy Examinations at Technician Level in Sri Lanka, suitable to G.C.E. (O/L) & (A/L) students, because it provides job opportunities at an early stage.

The AAT Sri Lanka is an internationally recognized professional institute holding Associate Membership of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) and the Confederation of Asian and Pacific Accountants (CAPA).

Examinations of AAT Sri Lanka

AAT Sri Lanka Examinations are held at 03 Levels - Accounting Assistant (AA1), Accounting Analyst (AA2) and Associate Accountant (AA3) in all three media, Sinhala, Tamil and English twice a year, in January and July. The duration of each level is 06 months. The three levels can be completed by G.C.E. (A/L) non-commerce & (O/L) Students in 1 1/2 years, and students who passed (A/L) in the commerce stream in 1 year. Examination Centres are located Island-wide for convenience of students.

Subject by Subject Pass Scheme

Students can pass the first two levels subject by subject. A student can sit for all the subjects of Accounting Assistant (AA1) and Accounting Analyst (AA2) levels together at one and the same examination.

Registration & Fees

Students are required to register with the institute to eligible to sit for Examinations. A "Students' Guide" which contains all details of AAT Sri Lanka Examinations, Syllabi of Subjects, application forms for registration, etc. priced at Rs. 150/- per copy at present should be obtained from the AAT office or from an information centre.

- Registration Fees - Rs. 1,500/- for school students
- Rs. 2,000/- for others

Criteria for Student Registration

- Six passes at G.C.E. (O/L) Examination (Sri Lanka / UK) or
- Two passes at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination (Sri Lanka / UK) or
- Five years experience as an Accounts Clerk / Book Keeper / Accounts Trainee in a recognized establishment or
- Any other equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Governing Council.

Exemptions

Exemptions from subjects of the AAT Sri Lanka Examination are available on the basis of:

- Passes at G.C.E. (A/L) for specific AAT subjects.
- Degrees awarded by recognized Universities.
- Diplomas and certificates awarded by Advanced Technical Institutes and Technical Colleges in Sri Lanka.
- Passes at examinations of other professional Institutes (for details, please refer the "Students' Guide").
