#### Question 07

**Sewwandi** a 26 year old unmarried girl, working as the Accountant of a leading finance company in Sri Lanka. She has joined that company in the year 2014.

- (a) **State** four(04) authorized deductions from the remuneration of **Sewwandi** according to the Shop and Office Employees' Act. (04 marks)
- (b) **Explain** leave entitlements applicable to **Sewwandi** under each of the following instances:
  - (i) **Sewwandi** falls sick and stays at home for 2 days.
  - (ii) **Sewwandi** getting married and requires 10 days as leave for her wedding.
  - (iii) **Sewwandi** becomes pregnant and ready for her first child delivery. (06 marks) (Total 10 marks)

#### Question 08

- (a) **Anil** hires, a motor vehicle, for three (03) years from **ABC Finance Company**, the financier with an option to repurchase the motor vehicle at the end of third year. **Anil** believes that he is the owner of the motor vehicle and this is a sale of goods contract.
  - **Explain** whether this transaction is governed by the Sale of Goods Ordinance. (04 marks)
- (b) Mihiran applied a life insurance policy from AR Insurance Co., a leading insurance company. He was asked by AR Insurance Co. whether he is having any other life insurance policies with other insurance companies. Though, he applied life insurance policies from other insurance companies, he did not reveal the fact that his application for life insurance had been rejected by several other insurance companies. Also he did not reveal about his bad health condition to AR Insurance Co. On relying Mihiran's facts, AR Insurance Co., issued a life insurance policy to Mihiran and after one year he died. Now Mihiran's wife wants to have the compensation.

**Explain** whether **Mihiran's** wife is entitled to claim the compensation from **AR Insurance Co.**

#### Question 09

Ann, her daughter Roshini and her son-in-law Gihan are partners of ARG Fashions, a successful garment business. They have been doing this business for ten years. Ann is now 65 years old and Roshini is expecting her first baby. Though they want to expand their business, none of them needs to get any risk or more liabilities. They are in the process of considering converting their partnership into a company and seek your advice on the advantages and disadvantages of converting a partnership into a private limited liability company.

**Explain** the advantages and disadvantages of a partnership compared to a private limited liability company. (10 marks)

#### Question 10

(a) Amal after passing his Advanced Level Examination has registered at a Professional Accounting Institute and followed classes in a private institution, to become an Accountant. His lecturers instructed all the students to buy non-programmable scientific calculators with specific functions. Amal went to buy such calculator from "Poth Sappuwa", a reputed book shop. Amal explained his requirements to sales officer of "Poth Sappuwa" and relied on such officer's judgment to buy the calculator. When he has taken the calculator to the class, his lecturer stated that it is not sufficient for the studies as required functions are not available in the calculator. Amal wanted to return the calculator to "Poth Sappuwa" and get the refund.

**Discuss** whether **Amal** is entitled to get the refund.

(b) A went to a film hall "Rideethira Cinema" to watch a newly released action film. Before the film was started, when showing notices and advertisements, a notice was shown stating that "the film hall is under repair and refurbishment of furniture and fittings is in progress, therefore the film hall management is not liable for any injury that may cause to any viewer in the audience". A, a great fan of action films, disregarded this notice shown in the screen and nervously waited to watch the film. When the film started, he attempted to imitate adventurous activities while being seated. Due to his movements on the chair, it was broken and A suffered severe injuries to his back. He was admitted to the nearest private hospital.

A claimed that his medical bills should be settled by the management of "Rideethira Cinema".

**Discuss** whether **A** is legally entitled to claim such medical expenses from the management of "Rideethira Cinema". (12 marks)
