Thank you Kasun for the confidence placed in me to help you with an analysis of your business performance for the year 2017/2018.

I am sure you are aware of the status of your business as a sole proprietorship in which the whole responsibility for success rests on your careful management and follow up of all its activities. It is therefore important to identify what are the items on which you have to lie very watchful so that, your profits may not get adversely affected.

It is observed that your net profit has increased by Rs.19,500/- from the last year which records a 13.7% growth, as against the gross profit increase of Rs.15,000/- which is 3.26%. Therefore we can conclude that the business is growing and not declining.

It is evident that sales returns have increased by Rs.10,000/- form the last year. This Problem has to be analyzed closely in order to ascertain the reasons. Is it due to quality of goods not meeting the requirements of customers or due to errors or omissions by the sales staff? It would be necessary to rectify the position by encouraging contractual measures.

The expenses appear to be under control. It is gratifying to note that office expenses have got reduced by 15,000/- than the previous year. The increase of Rs.10,000/- for salaries appears to be reasonable.

It is recommended to strengthen and carefully follow-up internal controls operating in the business in all respects. Since new rules and regulations are often introduced in the sports, cricket and tennis, it is recommended that "sports shop" is acquired with such developments to remain relevant in the trade.

The given Bar Chart depicts the unemployment rates in percentages of 10 districts the selected in a jumble order from the Republic of Sri Lanka. The source of the information whether it is from the government department of Census and Statistics or Central Bank Annual Report is not indicated.

The highest rate of 7.5% is recorded in the Matale District whereas the lowest of 2.5% is recorded in the Polonnaruwa district. Matara ditrict records the second highest rate of 6.3%. The next highest unemployment rate is in Galle and Kandy. Unemployment rate in Kurunegala is equal to that of Kalutara, but less than the rate in all other disricts except Polonnaruwa and Colombo.

The districts that show an unemployment rate of more than 6% are Matale and Matara. Ditricts that show an unemployment rate that is less than 3% are Colombo and Polonnaruwa.
