- i. **Macros**-In Word, you can automate frequently used tasks by creating and running macros. A macro is a series of commands and instructions that you group together as a single command to accomplish a task automatically.
- ii. **Word Art** - WordArt is a quick way to make text stand out with special effects.
- iii. **Paste Text (Keep Text only)** - When a selection copied to the clipboard includes content that is not text, the Keep Text Only option discards the content or converts it to text. For example, if you use the Keep Text Only option when you paste content that includes pictures and a table, the pictures are omitted from the pasted content, and the table is converted to a series of paragraphs.
- iv. **Comments** - In another way comment is a note or annotation that an author or reviewer can add to a document. Microsoft word displays the comment in the Reviewing pane or in a balloon in the margin of the document.

- v. **Smart Art** - SmartArt is a new type of graphical tool included in the latest versions of Word. SmartArt is, basically a way to make organized presentation art.
- vi. **Watermark** – The watermark feature can be used to embed a text or graphic to the background of a document, behind the text.

Chapter Reference- 05, Presentation and its key features

- I. **Slide Master** – In Microsoft PowerPoint, the Slide Master is the top slide that controls all information about the theme, layout, background, colour, fonts and positioning of all slides. Using the Slide Master can be an easy way to adjust the look of an existing theme or make overall changes to all slides in your presentation.
- II. **Play Narrations** - You can record audio right inside of PowerPoint, and have it playing while your viewer is watching the slideshow. In this, the audio stays synced to the slide timings you set while recording the audio. The play narration option enable this voice playing when required, if the audio is present.
- III. **Presenter View** - It lets you view your presentation with your speaker notes on one computer (your laptop, for example), while the audience views the notes-free presentation on a different monitor.
- IV. **Present Online** - You can broadcast your PowerPoint presentation over the Internet to a remote audience. While you present the slide show inside PowerPoint, your audience members follow along in their web browsers.

- V. **Hide Slide** - In a power point presentation, you can hide a slide just in case you'll need it later. Create hidden slides if you anticipate having to turn your presentation in a different direction-to answer a question from the audience, prove your point more thoroughly, or revisit a topic in more depth.
- VI. **Show Media Controls** – When embedding a video in a PowerPoint slide, media controls enable the video to be paused and played as required. You can specify how you want your video to play during a presentation, and set many other playback options. The options include playing a video automatically or when clicked, playing a video full screen, and looping a video.

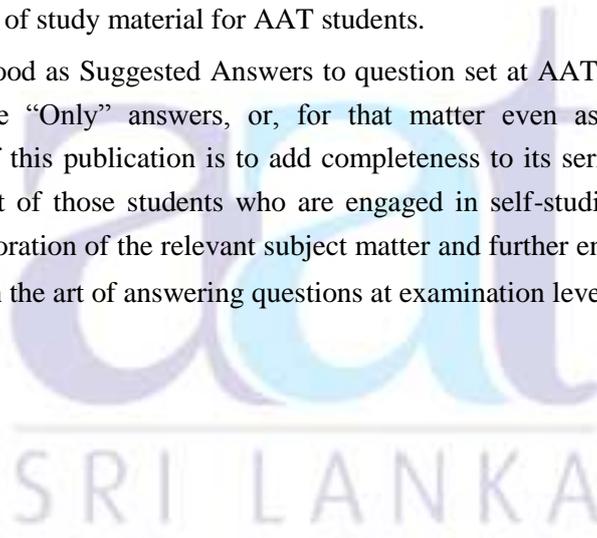
